Annual Fund

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The Annual Fund kicked-off Tuesday, November 15th and will run through December 20^{th.} The request for participation is \$5/family this year. The participation campaign and golf tournament are both a part of the overall Annual Fund campaign. The participation rate information can be used on our grant applications.

We are currently at 21% participation compared to an 86% participation rate last year. Mrs. Tonnis 8th grade homeroom won the contest for the class with 100% participation within the first 100hrs. So they will be rewarded with a free dress day. Mrs. King will work on a surprise for that class to congratulate them on their efforts. Mrs. Tonnis won a \$100 supply credit to her classroom.
