Demonstrate prompt and regular attendance
Provide content related and appropriate instruction based on Liberty Tech's school model
Use research-based instructional strategies to engage students in active, learner-led learning
Maintain lesson plans and use relevant data to plan instruction to meet the needs of all learners
Assess, document and prepare reports such as achievement progress, grade and classroom performance, and attendance
Provide a well-managed, safe and orderly environment that encourages respect for all
Participate in student-related conferences in order to enhance student learning
Perform additional activities and duties intended for school and student enhancement
Attend professional learning sessions and/or required conferences
Promote a positive school environment that enhances student learning
Perform other professional duties and responsibilities as assigned by the principal or designated school administrator

Required Duties & Responsibilities:

The employee must be able to satisfactorily perform each essential function of the position. When appropriate, reasonable accommodations will be provided to afford persons with disabilities an opportunity to perform the essential functions of the position. Employees are expected to attend all

required meetings as approved by the supervisor. Employees will adhere to the Georgia Professional Standards Commission's Code of Ethics for Educators.

Physical Demands of Teaching Positions:

As a teacher, there are routine physical activities that are required to fulfill job responsibilities. Ability to exert up to 50 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 20 pounds frequently, and/or up to 10 pounds of force constantly to move objects. Frequent bending, lifting, pushing, pulling, stooping, kneeling, crouching, reaching, handling, and repetitive fine motor activities. Prolonged periods of standing, walking and sitting. Vision, hearing, and verbal communications are essential functions of teaching positions.
