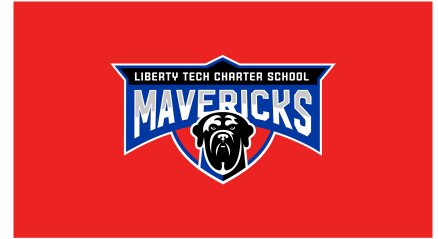

### **Speech Language Pathologist Job Description**

Position Type: (Part-Time) EXCEPTIONAL STUDENT EDUCATION (SPED)/Speech and Language Pathologist

#### **Qualifications**

- Minimum of an S-5 (Master's level) Georgia Educator Service Certification in Speech-Language Pathology
- High integrity, excellent character, and a good professional reputation are essential
- Abide by the Georgia Professional Standards Code of Ethics for Educators
- Ability to perform tasks involving prolonged periods of standing, walking, and sitting
- Ability to perform routine physical activities such as bending and lifting/pushing/pulling up to 50 pounds
- Ability to develop and implement Individualized Education Plans for students in grades K-8.

#### **Responsibilities**

- Implement procedures approved by the state, district, and the principal for identifying students with speech and language disabilities
- Conduct assessments, analyze results, and write reports promptly to determine strengths and deficit areas in speech, voice, fluency, pragmatics, language, and oral motor skills
- Ensure evaluations, IEPs, and service delivery comply with school, state, and federal guidelines
- Provide high-quality speech-language therapy services to students according to students' IEPs
- Ensure students' skills are generalized across settings by collaborating with principals and school staff
- Implement the program for speech and language students following district and state policies and regulations
- Participate in parent conferences, student support meetings, 504 meetings, special education eligibility meetings, and IEP meetings, as needed
- Perform all other duties and responsibilities as assigned

**Physical Demands of Teaching Positions:**

Frequent bending, lifting, pushing, pulling, stooping, kneeling, crouching, reaching, handling, and repetitive fine motor activities. Prolonged periods of standing, walking and sitting. Vision, hearing, and verbal communications are essential functions of this position.

**Reports to:** Special Education Coordinator and/or the designated administrator
